Balance of Trade

The deficit in the balance of formal trade in goods was US\$ 288.74 million in June 2023, a decrease of 12.20 per cent compared to the previous month of May. Year-over-year, the formal trade in goods deficit decreased by 1.28 per cent on the deficit of June 2022.

Exports
