



- The 4th Rwanda Population and Housing Census (PHC) has enumerated 1,726,370 residents in the Northern Province, which represent 16.4% of the total population of Rwanda (10,515,973 residents).
- The population of the Northern Province is predominantly female; 907,914 are women corresponding to 52.6% of the total population of the province.
- Gicumbi and Musanze are the mostly populated districts with 395,606 and 368,267 residents respectively. Their population represents 22.9% and 21.3% of the total resident population of the Northern Province respectively.
- The least populated district is Rulindo with 287,681 inhabitants, corresponding to 16.7% of the total resident population of the Northern Province.
- Three districts with a high population density (Inhabitants / .km²) are Musanze (694 inhabitants/km²), Burera (522 inhabitants/km²) and Rulindo (507 inhabitants /km²)
- The district with low population density (Inhabitants/km²) is Gicumbi (477 inhabitants/km²) followed by Gakenke (480 inhabitants/km²).

- The 4th Rwanda Population and Housing Census (PHC) has enumerated 287,681 residents in Rulindo district, which represent 16.7% of the total population of the Northern Province (1,726,370 residents).
- The population of Rulindo district is predominantly female; 152,056 are women corresponding to 52.9% of the total population.
- Females are predominant in all Sectors of the district as their respective proportion is more than 50% across sectors.
- Shyorongi, Buyoga, Masoro and Kisaro are the most populated sectors with more than 19, 000 residents each. They represent 8.2%, 7.7%, 7.2% and 6.9% of the total population of Rulindo district, respectively.
- Rusiga is the least populated in Rulindo district (10,888) and Ngoma (10,881 inhabitants). Each of them represents 3.8% of the total resident population of Rulindo district.

- Rulindo district population is predominantly rural: 97% of the resident population (279,051 inhabitants) lives in rural areas while only 3% lives in urban areas.
- Kinihira with 27.5% of the total population of the district and Shyorongi with 18.7% of the total population are the only urbanized sectors in Rulindo district.

- The population of Rulindo district is mostly young 59.6% of the resident population of Rulindo district is under 25 years old, as shown by the age pyramid (Figure 2), reflecting the high level of fertility in the recent past.
- The elderly (60 years and above) represent 5.9% of the total population of the district. The distribution of the resident population by age and by sector is in the annex.

Figure 4: Age pyramid of the resident population of Rulindo district in 2012



The percentages of the resident population in Rulindo district by marital status vary by sex and age:

- The percentage of the never married persons decreases from 99.5% (age group of 12-14 years) to 4.1% (age group of 85 years and above).
- The percentage of persons currently married starts by increasing from 0.4% (age group of 12-14 years) to a maximum of 80.2% (age group of 35-39 years) before decreasing to 33.3% (for people aged 85+) due mainly to widowhood.
- The high percentage of divorced persons is 2.9% (age group 40-44) while the high percentage of separated persons is 1.2% (age group 45-49).

School attendance among children varies across education levels:

- It is low (34.2%) for the preschool-age population (3-6 years), widespread (96.2%) for the primary school-age population (7-12 years), and moderate (71.8%) for the secondary school-age population (13-18 years) at the time of the census.
- School attendance varies also across the sectors:
 - ➤ The high attendance rate for the preschool-age population is 56.7% (in Kinihira sector) while the low is 21.1% (in Murambi sector).
 - For the primary school-age, the high rate is 98.0% in Kinihira sector while the low is 94.0% Ngoma sector.
 - ➤ For the secondary school, it varies from 80.8% in Burega to 66.1% in Ngoma sector.

- Table 11 reveals that not all children attending primary school level are of the official age for that level (7-12 years).
- The gross attendance rate varies from 133.3% in Ngoma to 150.8% in Kisaro sector.. The net attendance rate (NAR) in Primary school for Rulindo district (91.9%) is greater than the NAR at Province and National level (91.8% and 88.2%, respectively).
- The high net attendance rate in primary school is in Kinihira sector with 96.1% followed by Rukozo sector with 95.1% while the sector with the low NAR is Ngoma with 88.3%.

- As the national level, school attendance rate at secondary level is not universal in Rulindo district. The net and gross attendance rates in Rulindo district are below 50%. This means that more than half of Rulindo children who are supposed to attend secondary school are not actually attending that level.
 - There are some variations in attendance rates by sector. The high net attendance rate is observed in Burega (26.1%) and Bushoki (25.0%) while it is low in Cyungo (15.0%) and Ngoma (17.0%).
- Both net and gross attendance rates in Rulindo district are greater for females than for males. NAR for males is 17.8% while it is 25.0% for females. Gross attendance rate is 33.0% for males while it is 40.4% for females.

- The official working age in Rwanda is 16 years and above.
- Labor force participation varies by district in Northern Province: from 76.4% in Musanze and Rulindo district each to 80.7 in Gakenke district.
- 76.4 % of resident aged 16 years and above in Rulindo district are in labour market either working or looking for a job (economically active).

Figure 5 allows the study of the calendar and intensity of labour force participation and its variation by sex .The figure reveals:

- Early entry and late exit to the labour market in Rulindo district were around 30% at age of 16 (official entry age in the labor market) and around 75% at 65 years (official age of retirement).
- There is an intense labour force participation between ages 25 and 60 with more than 85% of the population into the labor market.
- There is a gender disparity in labour force participation across all age groups as males' labour force participation rate is greater than females' one for all age groups.



- Between 5 and 9 years few children (0.9%) were employed at the time of the Census at the national level. This percentage is 0.9% in Rulindo district and there is a no big difference between girls and boys.
- Between 10 years and 14 years the percentage of children who were employed during seven days preceding the census is 2.8% at the national level, while it is 2.5% in Rulindo district.



- The most commonly type of habitat found in Rulindo district is dispersed/isolated housing. 65.0% of the private households are of that type. It is followed by Clustered rural settlement (33.1%) and spontaneous/squatter housing (1.3%).
- The type of habitat varies a lot across sectors. The clustered rural settlement is most prevalent in some sectors such as Rukozo (65.9%), Cyungo (56.4%) and Tumba (47.4%). It is least prevalent in Cyinzuzi (7.1%) and Ngoma (9.4%).
- Dispersed/isolated housing units are mostly found in Cyinzuzi (92.2%), Ngoma (88.0%) and Burega (81.9%). They are least prevalent in Rukozo (33.8%) and Cyungo (43.0%).




Figure 9: Distribution (%) of the private households in Rulindo district by main material of the roof and by area of residence

- At the sector level, Ngoma (71.3%), Murambi (65.6%), Cyinzuzi (62.2%) and Ntarabana (60.2%) take the first place in using wood/mud on the walls. Bushoki (94.9%), Base (93.4%) and Rukozo (91.3%) are the first users of sundried bricks for walls building.




Figure 10: Distribution (%) of private households in Rulindo district by main material of the walls of the housing unit and by area of residence

- In Rulindo district, the main sources of energy for lighting used by private households are candles (20.9%) followed by kerosene lamp (19.2%) and firewood (5.8%). However, there is a high percentage of population that uses other unspecified sources of energy for lighting (47.6%)
- At the sector level, the percentage of population using electricity for lighting is high in Bushoki (15.5), Masoro (11.3%) and Base (11.4%). The low percentage of population that uses electricity for lighting is found in Burega sector.






Figure 13: Distribution (%) of the private households of Rulindo district by improved and unimproved source of water and by Sector





Figure 14: Distribution (%) of the private households of Rulindo district by main source of water and by area of residence




