## Gross Domestic Product – 2016 Q2

### I. Gross Domestic Product and its structure

In the second quarter of 2016, GDP at current market prices was estimated to be Rwf 1,549 billion, up from Rwf 1,428 billion in the same quarter of 2015. The Services sector contributed 48 percent of GDP while the agriculture sector contributed 33 percent of the GDP. The industry sector contributed 13 percent of the GDP and 6 percent was attributed to adjustment for taxes and subsidies on products.

### II. Growth rate by kind of activity<sup>1</sup>

In 2016 Q2, estimates calculated in 2011 prices shows that GDP was 5.4 percent higher in real terms compared to the same quarter of 2015.

In this quarter, “**Agriculture sector**” grew by 3 percent and contributed 0.9 percentage points to the overall GDP growth. Activities in the “**industry sector**” decreased by 2 percent and contributed negative 0.3 percentage points. “**Service sector**” increased by 9 percent and contributed 4.4 percentage points to the overall GDP.

### III. Expenditure GDP

In 2016 Q2, private final consumption expenditure was 77 percent of the GDP while government final consumption expenditure was 15 percent. Gross fixed capital formation is estimated at 25 percent of GDP. Change in inventories is estimated at 1 percent of the GDP.

In this quarter, exports increased by 16 percent, while imports increased by 10 percent.

### IV. GDP Deflator

Based on 2011=100, the implied GDP deflator is 121, in 2016 Q2, compared to 117 in 2015 Q2
