1. SUMMARY

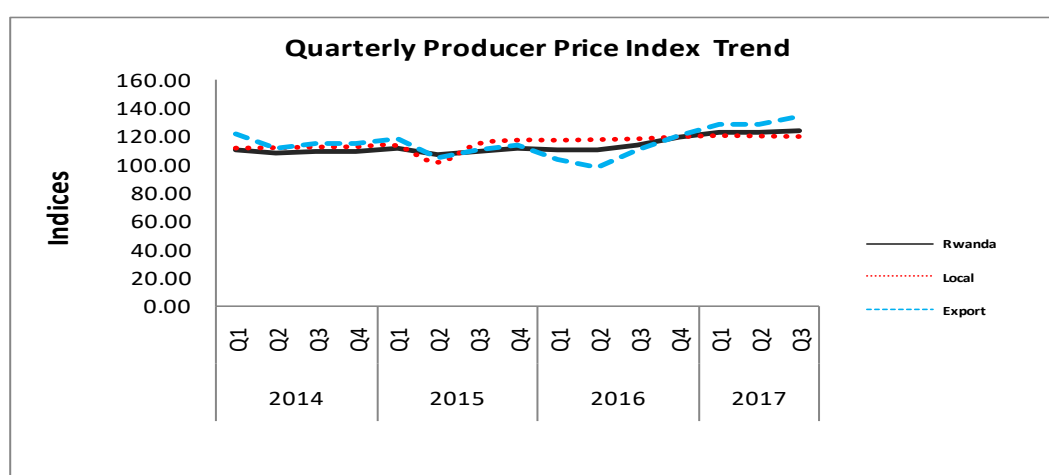
- The annual change in PPI for all Rwanda, third quarter 2017, is 9.11 percent
- The annual change in PPI for local products, third quarter 2017, is 1.30 percent
- The annual change in PPI for exports, third quarter 2017, is 20.70 percent
- The quarterly change in PPI for all Rwanda, third quarter 2017, is 1.00 percent
- The quarterly change in PPI for local products, third quarter 2017, is -0.29 percent
- The quarterly change in PPI for exports, third quarter 2017, is 4.13 percent

2. INTRODUCTION

The Producer Price Index (PPI) measures the average change over time in prices received by domestic producers for the production of their goods and services.

The Producer Price Index for Rwanda is published on a quarterly basis; but it highlights monthly Producer Price Index for each of the three months of the quarter under review, the quarterly Producer Price Index and the annual Producer Price Index.

It presents price changes for all combined products, products for local sales and that for exports. It covers a sample of 114 establishments and 402 products spread countrywide, both in Kigali City and in rural areas.

The Producer Price Index survey is conducted jointly with the National Bank of Rwanda. It now covers mining, manufacturing and energy; but NISR intends to include hotels and communication services in the future.

3. PPI FOR ALL RWANDA

The table below presents the percentage changes on monthly, quarterly and annual basis.

As the table 2 shows, on a monthly basis, the index decreased by 0.45 and 0.47 in July and August respectively and increased by 1.20 in September 2017.

On a quarterly basis, the index for the third quarter 2017 increased by 1.00 percent.

On an annual basis, the index for the third quarter 2017 increased by 9.11 percent.

Main contributors to change

On a monthly basis,

In July 2017 (-0.45%):

- Manufacturing contributed negatively by 1.09 percentage points.
- Mining and quarrying contributed positively by 0.64 percentage points.

In August 2017 (-0.47%):

- Manufacturing contributed negatively by 0.69 percentage points.
- Mining and quarrying contributed positively by 0.22 percentage points.

In September 2017 (1.20%)

- Manufacturing contributed positively by 1.14 percentage points.
- Mining and quarrying contributed positively by 0.07 percentage points.

On a quarterly basis, the main contributors to the index change of the third quarter 2017 (1.00%) are:

- Mining and quarrying contributed positively by 0.64 percentage points.
- Manufacturing contributed positively by 0.36 percentage points.

On an annual basis, the main contributors to the index change of the third quarter 2017 (9.11%) are:

- Manufacturing contributed positively by 8.88 percentage points of which food products contributed positively by 7.25 percentage points and beverages contributed positively by 0.93 percentage points

- Mining and quarrying contributed positively by 1.13 percentage points.
- Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply contributed negatively by 0.89 percentage points.

4. PPI FOR GOODS PRODUCED FOR LOCAL SALES

The table below presents the percentage changes on monthly, quarterly and annual basis.

As the table 3 shows, on a monthly basis, the index decreased by 0.84 and 1.00 in July and August respectively and increased by 0.75 in September 2017.

On a quarterly basis, the index for the third quarter 2017 decreased by 0.25 percent.

On an annual basis, the index for the third quarter 2017 increased by 1.30 percent.

Main contributors to change

On a monthly basis, the main contributors to the index change are:

In July 2017 (-0.84%):

- Manufacturing contributed negatively by 0.84 percentage point.

In August 2017(-1.00%):

- Manufacturing contributed negatively to 1.00 percentage point.

In September 2017 (0.75%):

- Manufacturing contributed positively to 0.75 percentage point.

On a quarterly basis, the main contributors to the index change (-0.25%):

- Manufacturing contributed negatively by 0.25 percentage points.

On an annual basis, the main contributors to the index change (1.30%):

- Manufacturing contributed positively by 1.60 percentage points.
- Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply contributed negatively by 0.31 percentage points.

5. PPI FOR EXPORTS

The table below presents the index and the percentage changes on monthly, quarterly and annual basis.

The table 4 shows that on a monthly basis the index increased by 0.55, 0.78, 2.15 in July, August and September 2017 respectively.

On a quarterly basis, the index for the third quarter 2017 increased by 4.13 percent.

On an annual basis, the index for the third quarter 2017 increased by 20.70 percent.

Main contributors to change

On a monthly basis,

In July 2017 (0.55%):

- Non-ferrous metal ores contributed positively by 0.54 percentage points
- Coffee products contributed positively by 0.46 percentage points.
- Tea products contributed negatively by 0.45 percentage points.

In August 2017 (0.78%):

- Tea products contributed positively by 2.18 percentage points.
- Non-ferrous metal ores contributed positively by 1.26 percentage points
- Coffee products contributed negatively by 2.80 percentage points

In September 2017 (2.15%):

- Coffee products contributed positively by 1.53 percentage points
- Tea products contributed positively by 0.42 percentage points.
- Non-ferrous metal ores contributed positively by 0.29 percentage points

On a quarterly basis, the main contributors to the index change of the third quarter 2017 (4.13%) are:

- Non-ferrous metal ores contributed positively by 2.89 percentage points
- Tea products contributed positively by 0.93 percentage points.
- Coffee products contributed positively by 0.28 percentage points

On an annual basis, the main contributors to the index change of third quarter 2017 (20.70%) are:

- Tea products contributed positively by 12.93 percentage points.
- Non-ferrous metal ores contributed positively by 5.75 percentage points
- Coffee products contributed positively by 1.88 percentage points.

6. TECHNICAL NOTE ON PPI

The Producer Price Index (PPI) measures the average change over time in the prices received by domestic producers of goods and services—goods and services which are output of production or enter in the production process.

NISR publishes PPI data for Mining, Manufacturing and Energy, and it will continue to be published quarterly, about 8 weeks following the quarter under review.

Over time the PPI will gradually be expanded to include other production sectors such as transportation, telecommunications, agriculture, and services. Expansion of PPI coverage depends upon the availability of data that could be used to derive weights.

The establishments are classified according to ISIC rev. 4; and the classification is determined by their main output.

The weights used in the PPI for Rwanda refer to the value of output (turnover without taxes) of establishments as reported in the 2011 Manpower survey collecting data for the year 2010, which constitutes the reference base period for the PPI calculation (September 2010).

The point of pricing is the establishment. The price is the selling price received by the producer for the selected product as it leaves the factory gate. In general, prices are collected each quarter from the selected establishment by considering the mid-point of each month of the quarter under review.

The formula used in the PPI calculation is the geometric modified Laspeyres.
