






GIRLS LITERACY RATE ON THE RISE

NET ATTENDANCE RATE


Urban areas record higher literacy and


participation rates than Rural areas

Children attend primary schools in abundance, which is not the case in secondary schools








SCHOOLING STATUS IN PRIMARY SCHOOL


Dropout and Repetition rates recorded fell short of the ESSP target by 2018
