





## GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT FIRST QUARTER 2020


### GDP growth rate

2,452 Billion Frw

In Q1 2020, GDP at current prices was estimated to be 2,452 Billion Frw, up from 2,152 in Q1 2019. Estimates calculated in 2017 prices show that GDP growth was 3.6% higher in real terms compared to Q1 2019.

### Sector share of GDP




In Q1 2020, Service sector contributed 48% of GDP, Agriculture 25%, Industry 19% while 8% was attributed to adjustment for taxes less subsidies on products.

This release captures the first direct effects of the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic, and the government measures taken to reduce transmission of the virus. There has been a widespread disruption to economic activity where in this quarter 1 (Jan-March) 2020, most economic activities experienced a slowdown in volume terms.

### Expenditure on GDP

In 2020 Q1, Final consumption expenditure of Household and Government contributed respectively 78% and 16% of total GDP.


In 2020 Q1, Gross capital formation contributed 25% to the total GDP, and grew by 10% in real terms.

In 2020 Q1, Exports of goods and services increased by 19% in real terms.

In 2020 Q1, Imports of good and services increased by 27% in real in real terms.

## 1. Gross Domestic Product and its structure

In the first quarter of 2020, GDP at current market prices was estimated to be Frw 2,452 billion, up from Frw 2,152 billion in Q1 2019. In this quarter, services sector contributed 48 percent of GDP, agriculture sector contributed 25 percent of the GDP, Industry sector contributed 19 percent of the GDP and 8 percent was attributed to adjustment for taxes and subsidies on products.



## 2. Growth rate by kind of activity

In this quarter, estimates calculated in 2017 prices show that GDP was 3.6 percent higher compared to the same quarter of 2019.

### 2.1. Agriculture

Agriculture decreased by 1% and reduced 0.1 percentage points to overall GDP growth. Within agriculture, food crops production decreased by 2%. Export crops decreased by 16% mainly due to a decrease of 38% in the production of Coffee. On the other hand, tea production increased by 21%.

### 2.2. Industry

Industry growth was 2% and contributed 0.3 percentage points to GDP growth. The main contributors in the industry sector were Construction activities which grew by 5% and Manufacturing activities which grew by 6%. Mining and Quarrying activities however decreased by 26%.

Manufacturing activities grew by 6%, due to an increase of 11% in food processing; 11% in Textiles, clothing & leather and 5% in production of Chemicals and plastic products boosted by the increase in the production of Soaps and other cleaning products. However, Wood & paper printing and Non-metallic mineral products declined by 11% and 6% respectively.


## 2.3. Services

The service sector grew by 6 percent and contributed 2.6 percentage points to overall GDP growth.

The growth in Services sector is due to an increase of 11% in wholesale & retail trade activities of locally made and imported products, 34% in Information & communication services, 14% increase in Public administration & defence, 32% increase in Human health & social work activities, 3% increase in Hotel & restaurant services and 1% increase in Administrative and support services. On the other side, Professional, scientific & technical activities decreased by 1%, and education decreased by 4%

## 3. Expenditure GDP

In Q1 of 2020, total final consumption expenditure increased by 7 percent, with Government final expenditures increasing by 15 percent while Household final consumption increased by 6 percent. Exports increased by 19 percent and imports by 27 percent while Gross capital formation increased by 10 percent.
