

The deficit in the balance of formal trade in goods was US\$ 134.69 million in December 2024, a decrease of 45.08 percent compared to the previous month of November 2024. Year-to-year, the formal trade in goods deficit decreased by 63.46 percent on the deficit of December 2023.

In the third quarter of 2024, Rwanda's total trade was US\$ 2,982.66 million, an increase of 41 percent over the third quarter of 2023. Domestic exports were estimated at US\$ 653.85 million; imports were estimated at US\$ 2,144.23 million and re-exports were estimated at US\$ 184.59 million.
