## Monthly Statistics of External Trade in Goods May 2022

## Balance of Trade

The deficit in the balance of formal trade in goods was US\$ 306.64 million in May 2022, an increase of 33.12 per cent compared to the previous month of April 2022. Year-over-year, the formal trade in goods deficit increased by 23.19 per cent on the deficit of May 2021.

## Exports

In May 2022 domestic exports values increased by 17.58 per cent compared to April 2022 and by 53.76 per cent compared to May 2021. Table 2 shows exported goods in value of exports in May 2022 by SITC sections.

In May 2022, total imports values increased by 27.43 per cent compared to April 2022 and by 32.29 per cent compared to May 2021.

In May 2022, re-exports values increased by 19.34 per cent compared to April 2022 and by 51.86 per cent compared to May 2021.
