



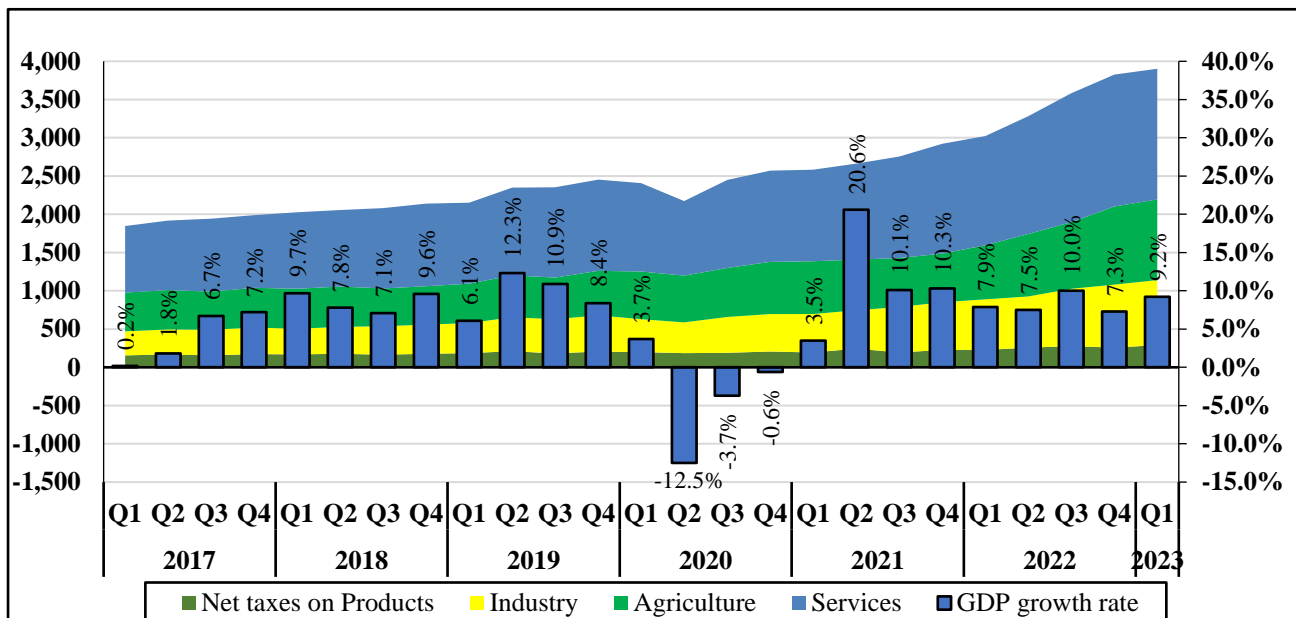

Gross Domestic Product – 2023 Q1

1. Gross Domestic Product and its structure

In the first quarter of 2023, GDP at current market prices was estimated at Frw 3, 901 billion, up from Frw 3,021 billion in Q1 2022. In this quarter, services sector contributed 44 percent of GDP, agriculture sector contributed 27 percent of the GDP, Industry sector contributed 22 percent of the GDP and 8 percent was attributed to adjustment for taxes and subsidies on products.

2. Growth rate by kind of activity

In this quarter, estimates calculated in 2017 prices show that GDP was 9.2 percent higher when compared to the same quarter of 2022.

2.1. Agriculture

Agricultural activities grew by 1 percent and contributed 0.2 percentage points to overall GDP growth. Within agriculture, the production of food crops decreased by 3 percent while the production of export crops increased by 25 percent.

2.2. Industry

Industrial activities grew by 9 percent and contributed 1.7 percentage points to GDP growth. Within industry, construction activities increased by 1 percent, Mining and quarrying increased by 15 percent, while manufacturing activities increased by 16 percent.

The growth in manufacturing was boosted by 22 percent increase in food processing; 26 percent increase in manufacturing of metal products, machinery & equipment; 37 percent increase in manufacturing of chemicals rubber & plastic products; 18 percent increase in manufacturing of wood & paper printing and 7 percent increase in manufacturing of non-metallic minerals manufacturing.

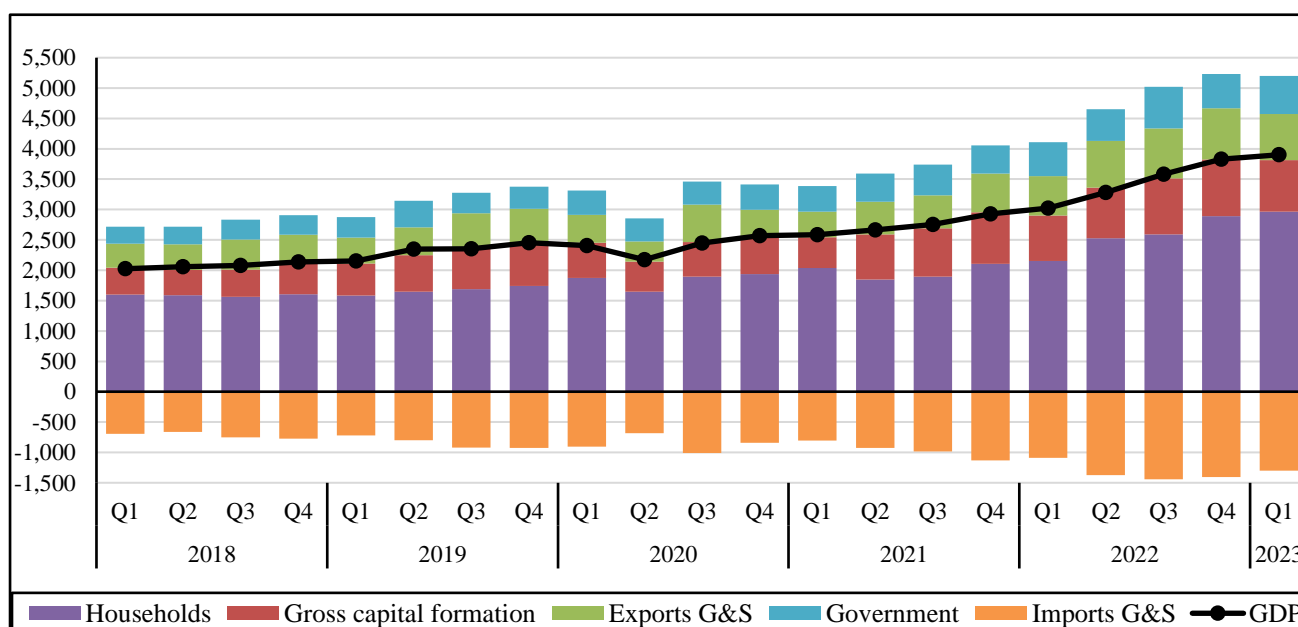
2.3. Services

Service sector grew by 13 percent. Within services, wholesale & retail trade increased by 17%; transport activities increased by 19%, hotel and restaurants grew by 42% and financial services increased by 12%, telecommunication services increased by 43%; professional & scientific services dropped by 6%. Public administration services increased by 7% and education services by 13%, however health services recorded negative growths of 3% following a high growth of 22% in the same quarter of 2022.

3. Expenditure GDP

In the first quarter of 2023, total final consumption expenditure increased by 10 percent, with Household final consumption increasing by 14 percent while Government final consumption decreasing by 7%. Exports increased by 6 percent and Imports remained unchanged while Gross Capital Formation decreased by 4 percent.
