## **Summary**

This is the monthly publication of the Producer Price Index (PPI) for the month of April 2024.

### On annual basis:

- ➤ General Producer Price Index increased by 10 percent;
- ➤ Local Producer Price Index increased by 7 percent;
- > Export Producer Price Index increased by 18.9 percent.

# On monthly basis:

- ➤ General Producer Price Index decreased by 0.2 percent;
- ➤ Local Producer Price Index increased by 1.1 percent;
- Export Producer Price Index decreased by 3.1 percent.

#### 1. Introduction

The Producer Price Index (PPI) measures the average change over time in prices received by domestic producers to produce their goods and services. The PPI for Rwanda is published on monthly basis. It presents price changes for all aggregated products, products for local sales and that for exports.

PPI survey covers a sample of 114 establishments and 402 products spread countrywide (Kigali and provinces). This survey is conducted in collaboration with the National Bank of Rwanda (NBR), and it covers mining, manufacturing, and utilities.

### 2. General Producer Price Index

Table below presents the percentage changes on monthly and annual basis.

In April 2024, the general PPI increased by 10 percent when compared to the same month of 2023. This increase is attributed to an increase of 12.9 percent in prices of manufacturing activities and an increase of 1.9 percent in prices of mining.

On monthly basis, the general PPI decreased by 0.2 percent. This is mainly due to a decrease of 0.2 percent in prices of manufacturing activities.

### 3. Local Producer Price Index

The table below presents the percentage changes on monthly and annual basis.

In April 2024, the local PPI increased by 7 percent when compared to the same month of 2023. This is due to an increase of 9.3 percent in prices of manufacturing activities.

On monthly basis, the local PPI increased by 1.1 percent. This is due to a decrease of 1.5 percent in prices of manufacturing activities.

## 4. Export Producer Price Index

The table below presents the percentage changes on monthly and annual basis.

In April 2024, the export PPI increased by 18.9 percent when compared to the same month of 2023. This is mainly due to an increase of 39.5 percent in prices of tea products, an increase of 12.4 percent in prices of coffee products and an increase of 1.9 percent in prices of mining.

On monthly basis, the export PPI decreased by 3.1 percent. This is due to an increase of 3.3 percent in prices of tea products and a decrease of 3.7 in prices of coffee.

#### Technical note on PPI

The Producer Price Index (PPI) measures the average change over time in the prices received by domestic producers of goods and services which are output of production or enter in the production process.

NISR publishes PPI data for Mining, Manufacturing and Energy, and it is published monthly, about 4 weeks following the month under review.

The establishments are classified according to ISIC rev. 4; and the classification is determined by their main output.

The weights used in the PPI for Rwanda refer to the value of output (turnover without taxes) of establishments as reported in the 2011 Manpower survey collecting data for the year 2010, which constitutes the reference base period for the PPI calculation (December 2010).

The point of pricing is the establishment. The price is the selling price received by the producer for the selected product as it leaves the factory gate. In general, prices are collected each month from the selected establishment by considering the mid-point of each month of the month under review.

The formula used in the PPI calculation is the geometric modified Laspeyres
