
# HEALTH & ECONOMIC SITUATION OF ADOLESCENTS IN RWANDA





#### DISTRIBUTION BY EDUCATION, USUAL ECONOMIC STATUS & INDUSTRY OF MAIN JOBS



There are more female students than male. And yet, females drop out of school more than males: only 0.1% of females have completed secondary, compared to the males who are 1%. Even if many adolescents drop out of school, the biggest percentage of Rwandan adolescents are employed, with agriculture/forestry/fishing being the most prevalent job activity.





under extreme poverty









### CURRENT USE OF CONTRACEPTIVE METHODS

(all women age: 15-19 years)









# PREGNANCY AND MOTHERHOOD BY PROVINCE
