## Balance of Trade

The deficit in the balance of formal trade in goods was US\$ 87.91 million in May 2017, an increase of 32.81 per cent when compared to the previous month of April. Year-over-year, the formal trade in goods deficit decreased by 14.47 per cent compared to the deficit of May 2016.

## Exports

In May 2017, domestic exports values increased by 15.12 per cent when compared to April 2017 and increased by 49.54 per cent vs. May 2016. Table 2 shows exported goods in US $\$$ million by SITC sections.
