- a) PhD or Masters Degree in Statistics or demography field with at least 10 years of experience in designing and implementing households and business surveys; development of master samples, development of statistical compendiums, data quality assessment frameworks, estimation of demographic indicators including population projections, etc in African countries, especially Sub-Saharan Africa.
- b) Demonstrated ability and at least 10 years of experience in surveys (households, business/establishments) and censuses data analysis, and conducting trainings for professional statisticians and demographers;
- c) Demonstrated ability and at least 10 years of experience in managing large statistical projects, preferably in National Statistical Offices;
- d) Fluency in English is required;
- e) Excellent abilities in the use of statistical packages (SPSS, STATA, CSPro, etc);
- f) Ability to work under busy working environment.
