The National Institute of Statistics of Rwanda received financing from the Basket Fund towards the cost of the STATISTICS FOR RESULT PROJECT, and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

The consulting services ("the Services") include providing support to the NSDS coordination team whose main aim is to fast track the implementation of all NSDS1 and Associated activities by the three required individual consultants.

The NSDS is a 5-year roadmap that looks at statistical priorities for Rwanda as a whole and provides a flexible framework both to produce statistics to meet immediate data needs and to build sustainable capacity to produce and use statistics in the future.

The NSDS Coordination Team (NCT) was then set up to coordinate project activities of all NSDS Basket Fund beneficiaries, manage planning reporting and auditing activities, and ensure compliance with the financial management and procurement procedures.

The National Institute of Statistics of Rwanda now invites eligible Individual Consultants to express their interest in providing the required services and seeks to hire the services of experienced and capable consultants as follows:

- 1. MONITORING AND EVALUATION SPECIALIST**
- 2. FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT SPECIALIST.**
- 3. PROCUREMENT ASSISTANT**

Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services.
