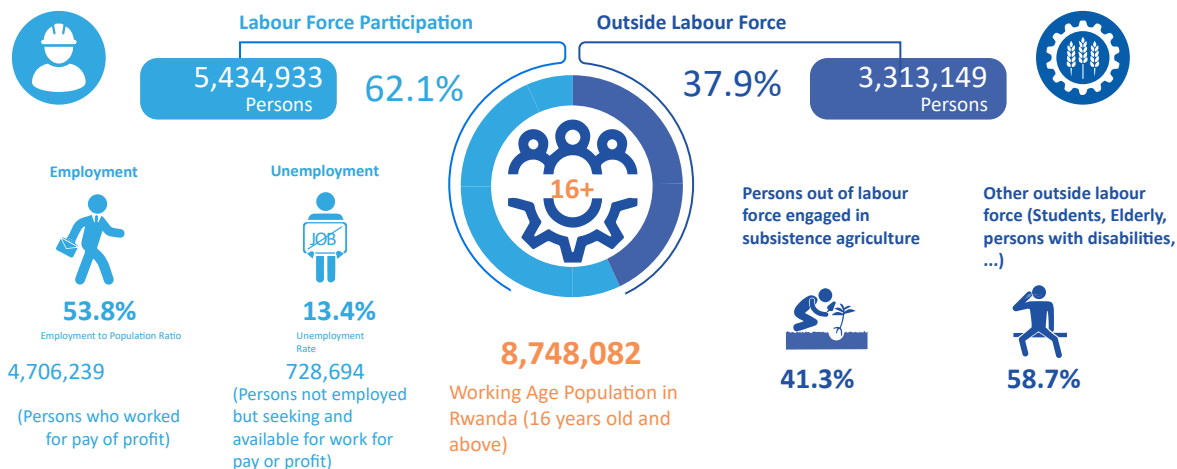

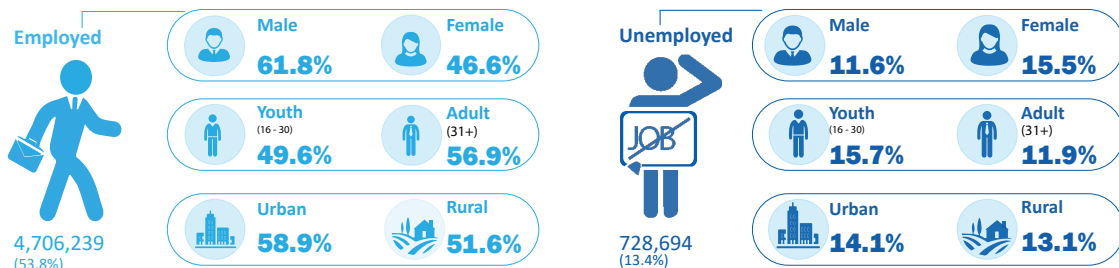

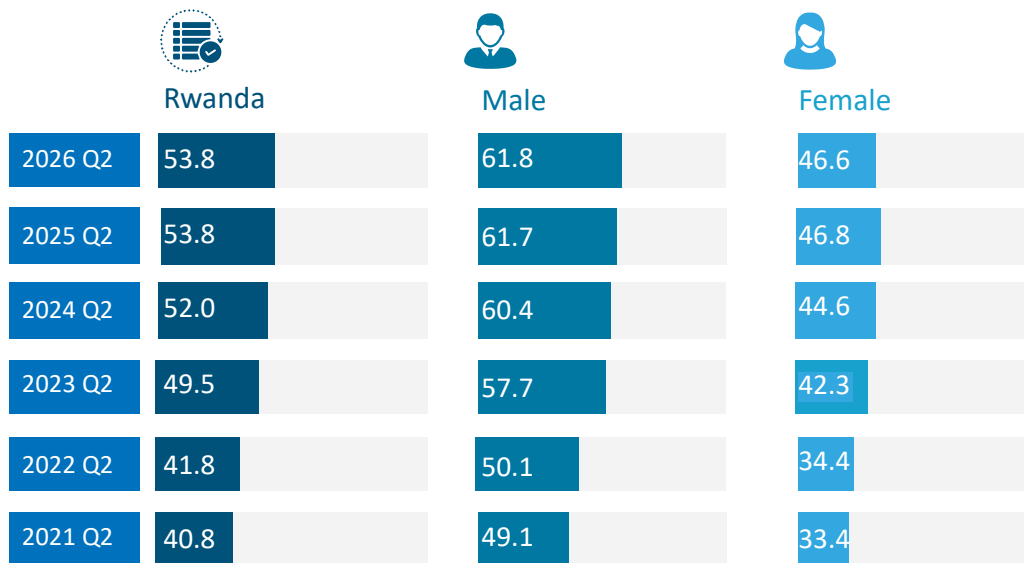

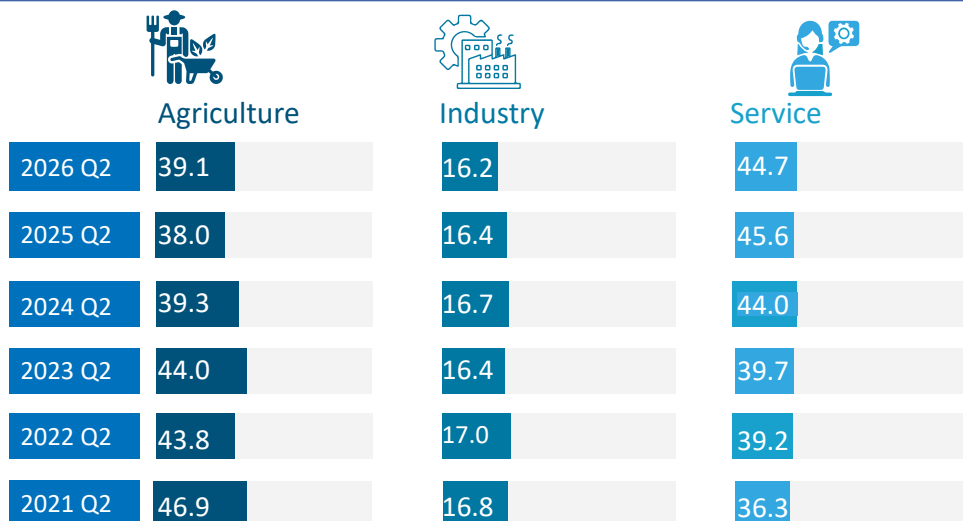

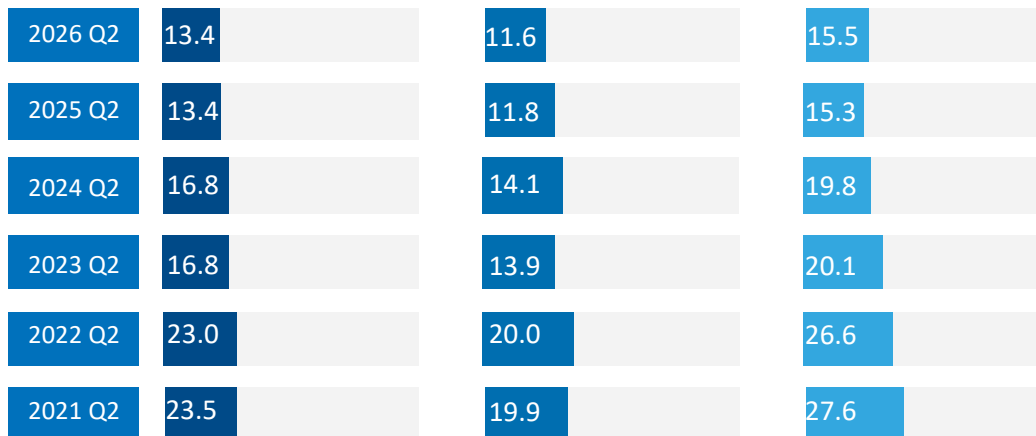

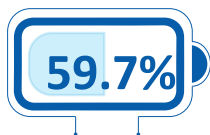

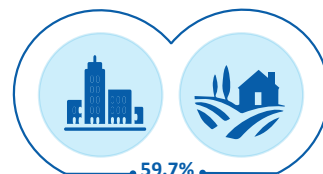

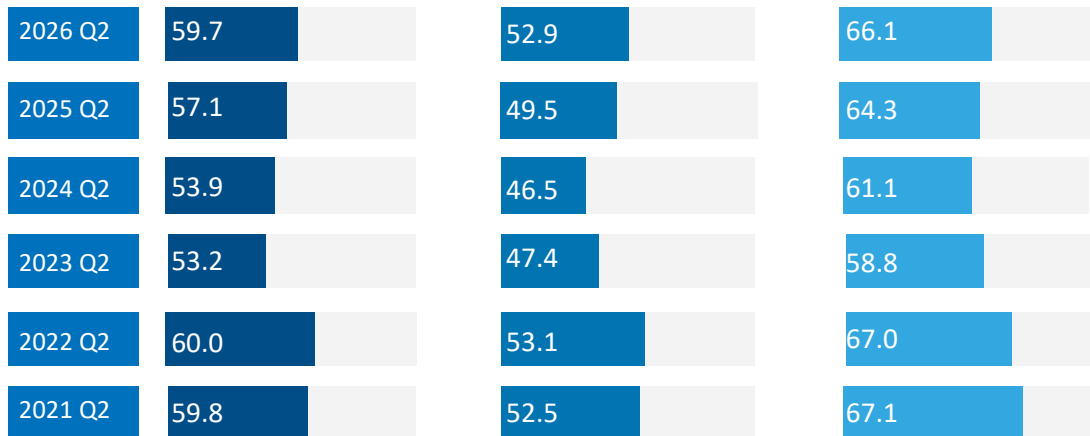

Trends (%) in Outside Labour Force



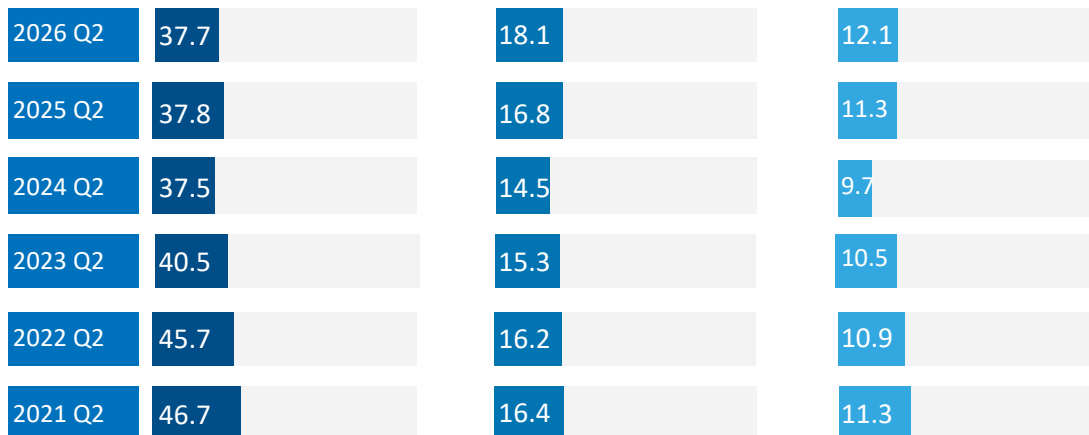

Employment	E
Unemployment	U
Time-related Underemployment	T
Labour Force Participation Rate	$LF/Pop16+$
Employment-population Ratio	$E/Pop16+$
Unemployment Rate (LU1)	U/LF
Combined Rate of Unemployment and Time-related Underemployment (LU2)	$(U+T)/LF$
Combined Rate of Unemployment and Potential Labour Force (LU3)	$(U+P)/XLF$
Composite Measure of Labour Underutilization (LU4)	$(U+T+P)/XLF$
