




Gross Domestic Product – 2020 Q2

1. Gross Domestic Product and its structure

In the second quarter of 2020, GDP at current market prices was estimated at Frw 2,175 billion, down from Frw 2,346 billion in Q2 of 2019. Services continue to lead in terms of shares to GDP with 45% compared to 28% and 19% shares for agriculture and industry respectively. The remainder 9% is attributed to net taxes on products



2. Growth rate by kind of activity

In this quarter, estimates calculated in 2017 prices show that GDP was 12.4 percent lower compared to the same quarter of 2019. This reflects the ongoing public health catastrophe of covid19 we are facing right now.

2.1. Agriculture

Agriculture fell by 2% and contributed -0.4 percentage points to overall GDP drop. Within agriculture, food crops production decreased by 2%. Export crops decreased by 19% mainly due to a -32% decrease in Coffee production, even though, the production of tea increased by 1%.

2.2. Industry

Industry dropped by 19% and contributed -3.5 percentage points to the GDP drop. The main contributor to the drop in the industry sector was Manufacturing activities which dropped by 13%, construction activities which dropped by 20% while Mining and quarrying dropped by 53%.

Within Manufacturing, Food processing increased by 0.3%. The remaining of Manufacturing activities dropped sharply mainly due to Covid19 as we observed a drop of -13% in Beverages, -13% in Textiles, -9% in Chemicals and plastic products and -14% in Non-metallic products.

2.3. Services


Services was also hit hard during this quarter. Some of its activities such as hotels and Restaurants, entertainment and tourism related activities are still restricted. The overall services sector decreased by 16%.

Within services, wholesale and retail trade activities decreased by 22%. We also observed a 41% drop in Transport activities, 62% drop in Hotel and restaurants, 8% drop in Financial services, 6% drop in Professional activities and 8% drop in Administrative and support activities.

Activities of public interests were also hit by Covid19 with Education dropping by 67% as schools were and remain closed, Public Administration also dropped by 3%. However, Health services increased by 5% while information and communication activities increased by 33% mainly boosted by telecommunication activities.

3. Expenditure GDP

In Q2 of 2020, total final consumption expenditure decreased by 5 percent, with Government final expenditures decreasing by 18 percent while Household final consumption decreased by 2 percent. Exports decreased by 24 percent and imports by 18 percent while Gross capital formation decreased by 34 percent.
